Lenten Regulations

FASTING, ALMSGIVING & prayer are the three traditional disciplines of Lent. The faithful and catechumens should undertake these practices seriously in a spirit of penance and of preparation for baptism or of renewal of baptism at Easter.

ASH WEDNESDAY, March 6, and **GOOD FRIDAY**, April, 19, are days of fast and abstinence. All Fridays of Lent are also days of abstinence from meat.

FASTING is to be observed **Ash Wednesday** and **Good Friday** by all Catholics between the ages of 18 and 59 years. On a fast day, one full meal is allowed. Two smaller meals, may be taken but together should not equal another full meal. Eating between meals is not permitted but liquids are allowed.

ABSTINENCE from meat is observed by anyone 14 years of age and older. **ASH WEDNESDAY**, and all **FRIDAYS** are days of **abstinence**.

Fr. John Mark Ettenson, OMI

Fr. John Mark Ettenson, OMI has been a Missionary Oblate of Mary Immaculate for thirty-three years. Ordained in 1989, he has served in ministry as a pastor, retreat/renewal preaching team director and member, spiritual director, writer, producer/director in television for o Media Productions, Director of Christ the King Retreat Center in Buffalo, Minnesota, and founding member of the Oblate Mission with Secularity (an effort to better determine how to be effective missionaries in a secular culture that the Oblates began in Indianapolis). Since 2011 he has been assigned full time to the preaching ministry. He has preached retreats or parish missions in 22 states and Canada.

Fr. John Mark's education has included a Bachelor of Science Degree in English and Word History, a Masters in Telecommunications, and a Master of Divinity Degree with emphasis in Word and Worship from the Catholic Theological Union in Chicago. He currently resides at Sacred Heart Parish in Oakland, California from where he continues to focus primarily on the preaching ministry.
