#### R.C.I.A. DISCUSSIONS Cardinal Virtues

A virtue is a habitual, firm disposition to do good. Virtues, like habits, need to be practiced. They can be lost

If they are neglected.

The theological virtues of Faith, Hope and Charity are gifts of God (CCC,Glossary, P.903). Moral virtues also known as Cardinal virtues are acquired through human effort aided by God's grace. The theological virtues are the most important because they come from God and lead to God.

Cardinal Virtues lead us to live in a close relationship with God through his grace. The Cardinal virtues are human virtues, acquired by education and good actions. The ultimate goal of a natural virtue is a good, decent life in this world. The following describes the Cardinal virtues.

**PRUDENCE:** the acquired habit of right judgment. Natural prudence is making good decisions in accordance with God's will, which is good and the very best for me, that will benefit me now and eternally.

**JUSTICE:** the constant and firm will to give their due to God and neighbor. Justice toward men predisposes us to respect the rights of each and to assure equity with regard to persons and to the common good. Justice toward God is called the "virtue of religion." The Christian gives to God what is due Him and to others what is due them as children of God.

**FORTITUDE:** is a firmness of mind or spirit in the daily challenges of life. The supernatural virtue of fortitude enables us to face extreme danger and endure life threatening difficulty to achieve the ultimate goal of salvation or help others achieve the same.

**TEMPERANCE:** means to moderate or order our desires involving the senses. The grace of supernatural temperance enables us through the power of our will ("willpower"), to use all things in moderation and to direct even the pleasurable things in life toward our salvation and the salvation of others.

During the coming week, pray for an increase of faith, hope, and love, and a desire to grow in the practice of the virtues.









