

The Eucharist

The Catholic doctrine of the Real Presence is the belief that Jesus Christ is literally, not symbolically, present in the Holy Eucharist —body, blood, soul and divinity. Because Jesus is not a liar, our belief in the Holy Eucharist is rooted in Christ Himself. "Truly, truly, I say to you, unless you eat the flesh of the Son of man and drink his blood, you have no life in you; he who eats my flesh and drinks his blood has eternal life, and I will raise him up at the last day. For my flesh is food indeed, and my blood is drink in deed. He who eats my flesh and drinks my blood abides in me, and I in him" (John 6:53-56

The Eucharist is not simply a sign or a symbol. It is Jesus really, truly and substantially present under the Eucharistic signs of bread and wine. At Mass, the priest speaks in Persona Christi, with the full authority of Christ, giving his words the power to change the elements. In the consecration of the Eucharist, the bread and wine really become the body and blood of Jesus Christ.

The Catechism of the Catholic Church says, "In the most blessed sacrament of the Eucharist 'the body and blood, together with the soul and divinity, of our Lord Jesus Christ and, therefore, the whole Christ is truly, really, and substantially contained." This is a key doctrine of the faith and a teaching that sets Catholics apart from most other Christians.

This miracle of God's physical presence to us at every Mass is the truest testament to Christ's love for us and His desire for each of us to have a personal relationship with Him.




