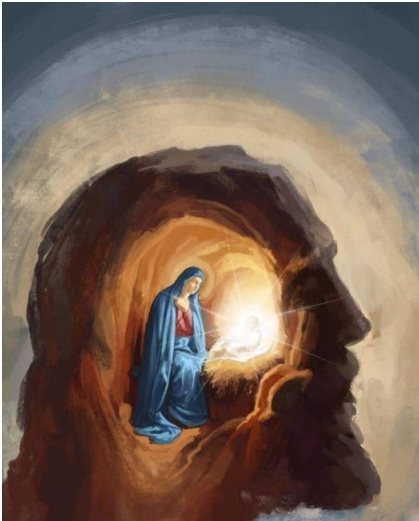

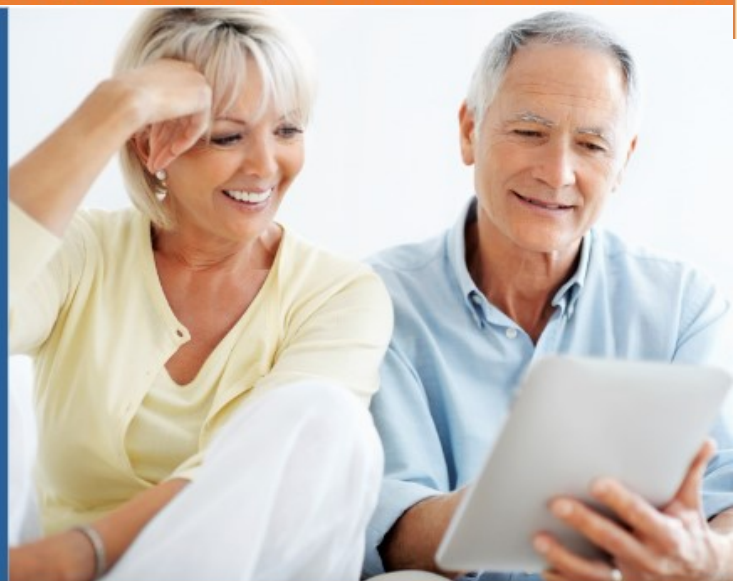

ITINERARY

✝ Wednesday, November 8, Day 1: DEPART USA

Depart on an overnight flight to Tel Aviv from Tampa Airport. Breakfast and dinner will be served on the flight. Premium economy and business class airfare quotes are available upon written request.

✝ Thursday, November 9, Day 2: ARRIVAL IN TEL AVIV – CAESAREA MARITIMA

Upon arrival in Tel Aviv, we pass through Immigration and Customs, collect our luggage and proceed to the Arrivals Hall. Here we will be met by our English-speaking Christian Tour Guide, who will accompany our group for the entire trip to the Holy Land. We proceed to the Sea of Galilee, where we settle into our hotel for a good night of rest. Dinner and overnight at our hotel at the Sea of Galilee (D)

✝ Friday, November 10, Day 3: NAZARETH – MT. PRECIPICE – CANA

Today, we explore Nazareth, the town of Mary's home, where Jesus played as a child, learned a trade, and grew to manhood. We visit Mary's Well and St. Joseph's Church. Mass will be celebrated at the Basilica of the Annunciation, where St. John Paul II celebrated Mass during his historic visit to the Holy Land in the Year of Our Lord 2000. We stop at Mt. Precipice, where we have a great view of the Jezreel Valley and from where the angry crowd wanted to throw Jesus off the mountain for his teachings. We visit Cana, where couples may choose to renew their wedding vows at the Wedding Church. Overnight at the Sea of Galilee. (B, D)

✝ Saturday, November 11, Day 4: THE SEA AND THE SHORES OF THE GALILEE

We start the morning with a boat ride on the Sea of Galilee and visit the "Jesus Boat," a boat from the time of Jesus. We see Magdala, home of St. Mary Magdalene. Mass is celebrated at the Mt. of Beatitudes. We enjoy St. Peter's Fish for lunch before departing for Capernaum, where Jesus began His Galilean ministry. Here we explore the synagogue, which dates to the time of Christ. We visit the church with a glass floor constructed over the site where St. Peter's home once stood. Below the glass, we can see the excavated ruins of Peter's house. Next, we visit the Church of the Primacy of Peter, situated on the shore of the Sea of Galilee, where after His Resurrection, Jesus met with his disciples and told Peter, "Feed my lambs; feed my sheep" (John 21:9). Our last stop is the Church of Multiplication of Loaves and Fishes, commemorating where Jesus fed the crowd of 5,000. Overnight at the Sea of Galilee (B, L, D)

✝ Sunday, November 12, Day 5: MT. TABOR – BEIT SHE'AN – BETHLEHEM

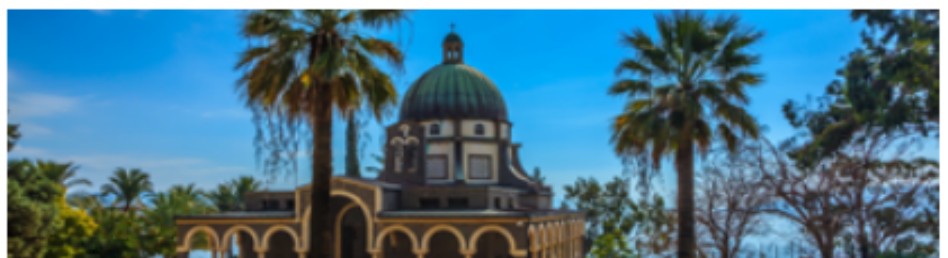
We start the day celebrating Mass on Mt. Tabor at the Church of Transfiguration, where Jesus transfigured before Peter, James, and John. Our next stop is the ancient Roman ruins of Beit She'an near Mt. Gilboa, where Saul and his son died in the battle with the Philistines. Continue to Bethlehem and check into our hotel. Dinner and overnight at our hotel in Bethlehem. (B, D)

✝ Monday, November 13, Day 6: BETHLEHEM – SHARING THE BREAD DINNER

Our first stop this morning is the Church of the Nativity built over the Grotto, where Our Lord Jesus Christ was born. Next door, we visit St. Catherine Church and the Grotto of St. Jerome, where we celebrate Mass. We continue with a visit to Shepherd's Field and Grotto. Following lunch on our own in a local restaurant, we shop at the Kando store, a co-op that employs over one hundred Christian families. Tonight we are welcomed into the homes of the local Christian families for a "Sharing the Bread Meal." Overnight in Bethlehem. (B, Special Dinner)

✝ Tuesday, November 14, Day 7: BETHANY – THE DEAD SEA – BAPTISMAL SITE – JERUSALEM

We visit Bethany to see the home of Mary, Martha, and Lazarus and to celebrate Mass at the Church of St. Lazarus. Driving through the Judean Desert, we arrive at Qasr Al Yehoud. This

site holds the oldest and most ancient tradition for being the place of Jesus' baptism by John the Baptist in the River Jordan (Mathew, 3: 13-17). Later, we drive to the Dead Sea to take a dip in the salty waters and shop for Dead Sea products. Don't forget to pack a bathing suit! We then head to Jerusalem to check into our hotel. Overnight in Jerusalem. (B, L, D)

✚ Wednesday, November 15, Day 8: MT. OF OLIVES – MT. ZION – JERUSALEM

This morning, we explore Ascension Chapel and visit the Church of Pater Noster, where Jesus taught The Lord's Prayer. Marvel at the panoramic view from the Mt. of Olives—appreciating the eternal golden city of Jerusalem. We walk along Palm Sunday Road, stopping at Dominus Flevit, where Jesus wept over the city. We continue along the Jewish cemetery with a view over the Eastern Gate. We have some quiet time in the Garden of Gethsemane and the Garden of Betrayal. Since the fourth century, tradition has placed the betrayal by Judas here. We celebrate Mass at the Basilica of Agony before visiting the empty tomb of the Virgin at The Church of the Assumption. Following lunch, we visit Caiaphas Palace and the Church of St. Peter in Gallicantu. Our final stops of the day are Dormition Abbey and the Upper Room. Overnight in Jerusalem. (B, D)

Thursday, November 16, Day 9: VIA DOLOROSA – TEMPLE MOUNT – WAILING WALL

Start the day early by praying the Stations of the Cross along the Way of the Cross (Via Dolorosa). We are blessed to be able to celebrate Mass this morning at the Church Holy Sepulchre, the site where Jesus was crucified and buried. Return to the hotel for breakfast and some rest. Later this morning, visit the Temple Mount and the Dome of the Rock, holy sites for Muslims, and the Western Wall excavations. We tuck a prayer into the Wailing Wall, as did St. John Paul II, Pope Benedict, and Pope Francis before us during their trips to the Holy Land. Time at leisure in the Old City. Overnight in Jerusalem. (B, D)

Friday, November 17, Day 10: OLD TOWN JERUSALEM – EIN KAREM – EMMAUS

Following breakfast, we depart for St. Anne's Church and see the Pools of Bethesda, where Jesus healed the Paralytic. Proceed to Ein Karem to visit the Church of the Visitation. See Mary's Spring and the birthplace of John the Baptist. Mass will be celebrated here. In the afternoon, time permitting, we visit Emmaus, where Jesus appeared to the two disciples after the Resurrection. Our farewell dinner is at a local restaurant and includes wine. Overnight Jerusalem (B, Special Dinner)*

Saturday, November 18, Day 11: ARRIVAL IN THE THE USA

This morning, we are transferred to the airport for our flight back to the USA. (B)
