"FAITH IS THE REALIZATION OF WHAT IS HOPED FOR AND EVIDENCE OF THINGS NOT SEEN" Hebrews 11:1

Faith is a longing for god and a general trust in his existence, presence, and goodness. Spiritual longing is part of our human nature. Although our faith has mysteries and supernatural realities, there are ways to know God.

Faith begins with trust, an essential element of a healthy relationship. In faith, we continue to seek and learn so we can live according to the truth. Faith requires from us "a personal act-the free response of the human person to the in initiative of God who reveals himself." (CCC166).

Faith is a journey. Our response to the gift of faith means that we must renew and refresh it again and again. Faith is hard and does not come easily. Just like the muscles of the body, faith must be exercised to grow. Faith must be exercised every day. We do this by prayer, the sacraments and good works.

It is impossible for our paltry good works to earn us eternal life in God's presence, any more than we could buy the crow jewels of England with a bottle cap. Scripture and Tradition is clear that "faith is more than a slogan or a feeling: It is a life in action.

The Catechism of the Catholic Church teaches that faith " is a gift pf God, a supernatural virtue infused by him" (153) through the sacrament of baptism. When Jesus commends someones's faith, he is often referring to some response that person has made to him.

At each Mass, Catholic belief is succinctly expressed in the profession of faith or credo called the Nicene Creed.
