### R.C.I.A. DISCUSSION

#### SING TO THE LORD

The importance of music in religion is clearly shown in the Bible. The verb "to sing" (with related words such as "song", and so forth) is one of the most commonly used words in the Bible. It occurs 309 times in the Old Testament and 36 times in the New. Liturgical music rises up out of the love that responds to God's love made flesh in Christ, the love that for us went into death.

As sacramental people we believe the senses of the body are goods and the things which appeal to those senses can be as well. The Mass calls upon all the senses: Taste and see, hear an feel and even smell is all part of the liturgical experiences. Incense, beautiful art, and song all serve as aids to worship.

The purpose of Sacred Music then is the glory of God and the sanctification (making-holy of the faithful. The mission of music at Mass is to worship God and lead the people in the worship of God. At Mass we are called to full, conscious and active participation. Our external actions of reading, singing, presenting gifts etc. helps us focus on the liturgy and the transforming power of God. Singing of the Church comes ultimately out of love. St. Augustine says singing is a lover's thing. It is the utter depth of love that produces the singing. The Holy Spirit is love, and it is he who produces the singing. He is the Spirit of Christ, the spirit who draws us into love for Christ and so leads to the

Father. (the Spirit of the Liturgy, pg. 142)

Singing in Church can be one of the most potent forms of worship. Feeling embarrassed or nervous about singing in public is a normal reaction that can be overcome through improving your confidence and developing your singing voice. Ultimately, it's more important that singing makes you happy rather than if it sounds good.

If we only realized that the God who loves us is intently listening at every Sunday Mass. Where two or three are gathered in my name, there am I in the midst of them. The angels and the saints are singing, and we have an opportunity to join in God's praises. Such a great opportunity is missed at most Sunday Masses. So let us raise our voices in praise during Mass.

and spread chaos and disaster.


During this hurricane season we turn to You,





