R.C.I.A. DISCUSSION CHURCH ETIQUETTE

For Catholics, the mass is a very solemn and sacred event in which they are renewed in faith by their encounter with the Real Presence of Jesus Christ and grow as a communion together with the universal Church. During this sacred moment of prayer it is important to keep a few things in mind when attending Mass.

DO arrive in the Church before the Mass begins. The opening and closing of doors, the movement of people in their pews and the disturbing of people to accommodate people arriving late is very distracting. Find a seat that will be the least disturbing to others.

DO cross yourself with Holy Water on entering and leaving the church. This is a reminder of our Baptism, which makes us members of Christ's Church.

DO genuflect (bow your knee) toward the Tabernacle when entering and leaving our row. By allowing our right knee to hit the floor, we acknowledge Christ our Lord and God. If someone is physically unable to genuflect, then a reverent bow is sufficient. If you pass in front of the altar or tabernacle, bow reverently.

DO spend a few moments saying hello to Jesus before talking to the other guests as He is your host. Then **take the opportunity to review the Bible readings, prepare yourself in prayer, or reflect on what you wish to bring to Jesus during the Mass.**

DO come to Mass with your offering prepared. Never dig into the basket for change.

DON'T read the bulletin during Mass. Imagine if you invited a guest to your house and during dinner they decided to read a magazine instead of talking to you. That is what is happening in God's house when you read the bulletin at Mass. Take the time to speak with Jesus, your host.

DON'T visit with your neighbor in the church before or during Mass so you don't disturb those who are in prayer. Once you are outside of the main sanctuary, visit with others especially your pastor as a part of Christian fellowship.

DON'T chew gum, drink water, eat candy, or cough drops. It is Church law that one fasts for at least 1 hour before receiving Holy Communion. Water and medicine can be consumed before coming to church of course. The purpose is to help us prepare to receive Jesus in the Eucharist.

DON'T leave early unless there is an urgent issue. Mass is ended when the recession hymn ends. While there are certainly exceptions to this guideline, most who leave early don't need to and ought not to. Getting out of the parking lot before others is not a valid reason.

Reminder: The first person who left Mass early was Judas. Be respectful of God, the Priest and our Fellow Worshipers.
