R.C.I.A. DISCUSSION

CONFESSION

Only God can forgive sins (CCC,1441-1442). But Christ also wished that this power would be mediated through the Apostles. So, Jesus gave his priests the power to forgive sins in his name. (John 20:23).

Bishops and priests who are the successors of the Apostles are now entrusted with the ministry of reconciliation (CCC,1461). The Catholic Church has always upheld the necessity of seeking forgiveness of sin the way Christ intended it to be sought.

When confessing to a priest, the Catholic experiences a lesson in humility which is circumvented when one confesses to God only through private prayer. We all desire to escape humbling experiences. By going to a priest who is a trained confessor, the faithful is protected against the subjective dangers of such psychological tricks of the personality such as projection, rationalization, etc. The priest offers sound and objective advice in analyzing our sins and help us in avoiding sin in the future.

This power to forgive is two –fold, to loose (to forgive) or to hold them bound (not to forgive). This means that sins had to be verbally confessed to the priests so they could know which sins to forgive and which not to forgive. The priest prays the prayer of absolution that expresses God’s forgiveness. Then a Catholic is assured that his sins are forgiven; he doesn’t have to rely on a subjective “feeling”. Through the sacrament of penance, not only are sins forgiven, but graces are obtained.
