### R.C.I.A. DISCUSSION

#### HOW TO RECEIVE HOLY COMMUNION

When we approach the altar for Holy Communion, we are proclaiming our belief in the truth that the Eucharist is really and truly the body, soul, and divinity of our Lord Jesus Christ. It is not just a symbol or representation! Because of this, we should approach communion with devotion, reverence, and respect. These guidelines help us approach Holy Communion with reverence.

Fast for at least one hour before Mass. We pray and fast before Mass in order to prepare ourselves for Holy Communion and to offer ourselves as a pure sacrifice to our Lord. Taking water (not coffee, tea, or soft drink) with medication does not break the fast requirement.

You must not be conscious of any grave sin: It is seriously wrong to receive our Lord while in a state of grave (mortal) sin. Saint Paul teaches in 1 Corinthians 11:P27-29 that, “whoever, therefore, eats the bread or drinks the cup of the Lord in an unworthy manner will be guilty of profaning the body and blood of the Lord. Let a man examine himself, and so eat of the bread and drink of the cup. For anyone who eats and drinks without discerning the body eats and drinks judgment upon himself”. If you are conscious of grave sin, you are to receive the Sacrament of Reconciliation before receiving Holy Communion. If you require more information on why it is essential to be in the state of grace in order to receive communion, please do not hesitate to speak to a member of the clergy (priest or deacon).

To receive Holy Communion with reverence and devotion, make a reverential bow in respect to our Eucharistic Lord before approaching the priest or Extraordinary Minister of Communion. When they say either “the body of Christ” or the blood of Christ”, your response should be “Amen”. This word means, “So be it”, “It is So”, or “I believe”. Please say it clearly and distinctly.

You can receive Holy Communion either on the tongue or in the hands. If you choose to receive in the hands, place your right hand over your left (in the shape of a little throne to receive the King of Kings).

Take a step to the side and consume the host immediately. Do not wait until you return to your seat. If you choose to receive Holy Communion on the tongue, then, with head straight or tilted slightly back, open your mouth wide and extend your tongue over the lower lip. The priest/minister will place the Sacred Host on your tongue. When the Sacred Host is safely placed on the tongue you may return your tongue and close your mouth.

These guidelines are set forth by the Congregation of Divine Worship in Rome as well as the United States Conference of Catholic Bishops. Following these guidelines will help to protect and promote the sanctity of the Holy Mass whenever it is celebrated. More importantly, you will cultivate a greater spirit of devotion and reverence for the Eucharistic Lord within your own soul. God bless you!
