Lenten Regulations

FASTING,ALMSGIVING & prayer are the three traditional disciplines of Lent. The faithful and catechumens should undertake these practices seriously in a spirit of penance and of preparation for baptism or of renewal of baptism at Easter.

ASH WEDNESDAY ,March 6, and **GOOD FRIDAY**, April, 19, are days of fast and abstinence. All Fridays of Lent are also days of abstinence from meat.

FASTING is to be observed **Ash Wednesday** and **Good Friday** by all Catholics between the ages of 18 and 59 years. On a fast day, one full meal is allowed. Two smaller meals, may be taken but together should not equal another full meal. Eating between meals is not permitted but liquids are allowed.

ABSTINENCE from meat is observed by anyone 14 years of age and older. **ASH WEDNESDAY**, and all **FRIDAYS** are days of **abstinence**.

You may have heard the term Consistent Ethic of Life and wondered about it.

The late Cardinal Joseph Bernardin, defined the consistent of life as "... "one which stands for protection of the right to life and the promotion of the rights which enhance life from womb to natural death... It joins the humanity of the unborn infant and the humanity of the hungry; it calls for positive legal action to prevent the killing of the unborn or the aged and positive societal action to provide shelter for the homeless and education of the illiterate."

In his powerful encyclical Evangelium Vitae ("The Gospel of Life"), St. John Paul II taught: "Where life is involved, the service of charity must be profoundly consistent. It cannot tolerate bias and discrimination."

The United States Conference of Catholic Bishops have clearly defined seven themes. These Seven Themes of Catholic Social Teaching address issues on matters of human dignity and common good in society. These philosophies present the role of the state, social organization, concern for social justice, and issues of wealth.
