Lenten Regulations

FASTING, ALMSGIVING & prayer are the three traditional disciplines of Lent. The faithful and catechumens should undertake these practices seriously in a spirit of penance and of preparation for baptism or of renewal of baptism at Easter.

ASH WEDNESDAY, March 6, and GOOD FRIDAY, April, 19, are days of fast and abstinence. All Fridays of Lent are also days of abstinence from meat.

FASTING is to be observed Ash Wednesday and Good Friday by all Catholics between the ages of 18 and 59 years. On a fast day, one full meal is allowed. Two smaller meals, may be taken but together should not equal another full meal. Eating between meals is not permitted but liquids are allowed.

ABSTINENCE from meat is observed by anyone 14 years of age and older. ASH WEDNESDAY, and all FRIDAYS are days of abstinence.
