R.C.I.A. THE BEATITUDES

The word "beatitude" is derived from the Latin word 'beatus' (meaning 'blessed'). Attitude is defined as a manner of thinking, feeling, or behaving that reflects a state of mind or disposition.

The Beatitudes calls each of us living in the world to imitate Christ, transforming the ordinary Christian into a saint. They exemplify simplicity, truth and beauty in moral theology. We know for sure that it is possible to live by them and put them into practice. God never asks the impossible from any of us. We do need God's grace and just plain human willingness to abide by them. Faithful Catholics should memorize the Beatitudes and consider them often.

THE EIGHT BEATITUDES OF JESUS

1)Blessed are the poor in spirit, for theirs is the kingdom of heaven.

2)Blessed are they who mourn, for they shall be comforted.

3)Blessed are the meek, for they shall inherit thee earth.

4)Blessed are they who hunger and thirst for righteousness, for they shall be satisfied.

5)Blessed are the merciful, for they shall obtain mercy.

6)Blessed are the pure of heart, for they shall see God.

7)Blessed are the peace makers, for they shall be called children of God.

8)Blessed are they who are persecuted for the sake of righteousness, for theirs is the kingdom of heaven.
