RCIA DISCUSSIONS THE TEN COMMANDMENTS

The foundation of Christian moral life is in the Ten Commandments. The Ten Commandments are a summary of "the conditions of a life freed from the slavery of sin" (Catechism, 2057). The Commandments are divine law because God himself revealed them. And they were spelled out specifically with no room for ambiguity.

The Church doesn't see the Ten Commandments as arbitrary rules and regulations from God but as commandments for protection. Obey them and eternal happiness is yours. Disobey them and suffer the consequences. Each Commandment is a summary of a whole category of actions. For example, "bearing false witness against your neighbor" covers any kind of falsehood: perjury, lying, slander, detraction, rash judgment, etc.

The Commandments express man's fundamental duties to God and neighbor. To violate them knowingly & willingly in a significant way is to commit mortal sin. (See *Catechism*, #2702-3). In His teaching, Jesus often referred to the Ten Commandments and assures their validity in his dialog with the rich young man in Matthew's Gospel (Mt 19:16-21).

Catholic tradition uses the division of the Commandments established by St. Augustine.

Other Judeo-Christian traditions use the same Scriptural content for the Ten Commandments but may number them differently.

The Ten <u>commandments</u> were given by God to Moses on Mount Sinai. Jesus gave us the beatitudes in his sermon on the mount. As different as the settings of the Ten Commandments and the Beatitudes were, they come from the same God. The effect of obeying the Ten Commandments is happiness. Building on the foundation of the Commandments, Jesus gave us the model of how to live the reality of commandments here on earth through the Beatitudes.

THE TEN COMMANDMENTS

- 1) I am the LORD your God: you shall not have strange Gods before me.
- 2)You shall not take the name of the

LORD your God in vain.

- 3) Remember to keep holy the LORD'S Day.
- 4)Honor your father and your mother.
- 5)You shall not kill.

- 6)You shall not commit adultery.
- 7)You shall not steal.
- 8)You shall not bear false witness against your neighbor.
- 9)You shall not covet your neighbor's wife.
- 10)You shall not covet your

Homebound & Nursing Home Ministry







