R.C.I.A. DISCUSSIONS What is R.C.I.A.

The Rite of Christian Initiation for Adults or RCIA, is a process for the formal initiation of new members into the Catholic Church. RCIA is designed to assist the adult and older children who desire to be fully initiated into the Catholic Church. The participants study the Gospel and learn how to live the Catholic way of life. During this process, which is marked by regular ritual acts, participants are introduced to the liturgy, the teachings, and the life of the Catholic Church.

Catechumens are those people who are seeking full initiation into the Catholic Church through the Sacraments of initiation– Baptism, Eucharist and Confirmation. The longest part of the process, the Catechumenate is a time of learning and formation in the traditions and doctrine of the Catholic Church. This is a time of sharing stories, reading scripture, and studying the Church customs, traditions and doctrine. Participants also participate in worship services and various church ritual.

Candidates are people who have been baptized in a Christian tradition but are seeking initiation into the Catholic Church trough Eucharist and Confirmation. Adults or older children who are baptized in another Christian denomination prepare in a similar way for the sacraments of Confirmation and the Eucharist during their reception into the Cathjolic Church.

The Rite of Christian Initiation for Adults is a process that proceeds over weeks and months. It is a journey that is unique to each seeker. Catechumens and Candidates are chosen to be received into the Church by the Bishop and the community.

At the Easter Vigil (Holy Saturday), those who have been journeying through the RCIA process are welcomed formally into the community of believers through receiving the Sacraments of Initiation– Baptism, Eucharist and Confirmation .

Certain requirements for selection apply: men must be over 35 years of age and younger than 60 in 2025, and have had stable marriages for at least five years.
