### R.C.I.A. DISCUSSION

## Catholic Ecclesial Movements

Our Holy Fathers and the bishops call the Catholic faithful to undertake a “New Evangelization.” In our modern times ecclesial movements represent “a *new era of group endeavors* of the lay faithful” (John Paul II, apostolic exhortation *On the Vocation and the Mission of the Lay Faithful in the Church and in the World* [*Christifideles Laici*], no. 29).

Catholic movements provide the channel by which the Christian faithful strive to foster a more perfect life in Christ, to promote public worship or Christian doctrine, or to exercise their apostolate of evangelization through works of piety or charity. Some examples of contemporary ecclesial movements that exist in the United States today are:

***Catholic Charismatic Renewal***, a spiritual movement within the Catholic Church that incorporates aspects of both Catholic and charismatic practice. Prayer meetings are held outside of Mass and feature such gifts as prophecy, faith healing, and speaking in an unknown language. Incarnation Church in Sarasota has an active Charismatic group.

***Cursillo***, a Catholic-based training program described as a short course of Christianity. Members are encouraged to take what they learned that over a three day weekend and apply it to their daily lives. The Program is offered by the diocese every year.

***Couples for Christ*** an international Catholic lay ecclesial movement whose goal is to renew and strengthen Christian values. The organization is affiliated with the Vatican recognition from the Pontifical Council for the Laity.

***Jesus Youth*** an initiative of young people themselves, who, filled with the Holy Spirit try to reach out to other young people. The strength of the movement is its special focus on a life centered on the Lord Jesus Christ: beginning with an experience of God nourished by prayer, the Word of God, the sacraments and fellowship, and sharing the Good News of Jesus Christ with others.
