R.C.I.A. DISCUSSIONS THE SACRAMENT OF BAPTISM (Catechism of the Catholic Church #1213)

Original sin is the **absence** of something that should be there. It is a darkness where there ought to be light. When the sacrament of Baptism is administered, the spiritual vacuum which we call original sin disappears. God becomes present in the soul, and the soul is filled with **sanctifying grace**.

The sacrament of Baptism makes us adopted children of God and heirs of heaven. Our inheritance is the eternal union with God. Nobody can take this inheritance away. Not even God. But we ourselves renounce our rights when we commit mortal sin.

When we sin, we lose sanctifying grace. But because we are baptized, we have the right to receive the sacrament of Penance (Reconciliation, or Confession) and regain the grace that we have lost through our individual sins after Baptism. There is no escaping the absolute necessity of Baptism.

"Unless a man be born again of water and the Spirit, he cannot enter into the kingdom of God," Jesus told Nicodemus (John 3:5). And His command to the Apostles was: "Go into the whole world and preach the Gospel to every creature. He who believes and is baptized shall be saved, but he who does not believe" (and, by inference, is not baptized) "shall be condemned" (Mark 16:15-16).


There is no "if" or "maybe" about these two statements; no way around them.


